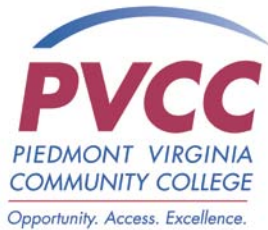

### **Superlatives / Recent Accolades:**

In 2010, PVCC opened two new buildings – the Kluge-Moses Science Building and the Stultz Center for Business and Career Development. Both facilities provide much-needed space for new programs that directly prepare people for jobs in our community. After months of extensive construction, renovation and enhancements, the facilities opened for classes in the summer 2010 term.

The new facilities allow PVCC's Health and Life Sciences and Workforce Services Divisions to expand course offerings with new programs of study including Diagnostic Medical Sonography, Radiography, Practical Nursing, Building Trades and Computer and Networking Support Technologies. These programs vary from one semester to two years in length, and graduates are in demand despite the current recession.
